"I recently purchased a GLIND AUSSIE BOAT SHOWER for my 35 foot Motor Cruiser "Beau-Soot". The operation of this unit exceeded my wildest expectations so thought I would tell you about it.

I have been rebuilding the boat for some time and in the course of events looked at storage hot water systems. A big problem in fitting a storage hot water system is that it needs a lot of space. They occupy a lot of space to provide a convenience not that often used.

I searched the internet and came across the promise of a compact hot water system....The Glind Marine....was it true or just another pipe dream? After a lot of downloads and reading I was transferred to another world but did not know if it was fact or fiction. I was promised hot water to give me a shower by a system that did not occupy a lot of space. Sure you run the motors for a short time to get the water but it is a small price to pay for the advantages of the unit.

Had a few discussions with the principal Tim Nearhos who gave me a lot of good advice and then supplied me with a marine unit and so began my introduction to the Glind.

- The unit arrived and contained everything I needed down to the smallest clip and a great set of instructions that even I could understand

- Then the test and it was at this point that my wildest expectations were exceeded. I now had hot water for a shower without the disadvantages of a storage unit.
- The unit supplies hot water to the bathroom shower and I am at present extending it to supply hot water to the kitchen
- As the boat has two motors I will be getting another unit for the second motor in the future
